

Survey Technician

Summary of Duties:

Survey Crew Technician positions available to work in support of civil engineering and land surveying projects throughout South Carolina. The Survey Crew Technician is responsible for operating conventional total station surveying equipment, survey grade RTK GPS equipment, Levels, Data Collectors, etc., and stocking and maintaining survey vehicles. The Survey Crew Technician is also responsible for the accurate and effective collection of survey data to be used in the preparation of plats and civil engineering design plans. Experience in route surveys, construction staking, traversing, boundary surveys, topographic surveys, control surveys, and other fundamental survey fieldwork. Responsibilities also include ensuring that survey vehicles are loaded with all supplies necessary for the completion of the specified assignments. This is an outdoor, field position. Sound physical condition is a must! The Survey Crew Technician reports to Survey Party Chief and the Survey Manager. This position may require occasional travel.

Requirements:

Associate's degree in engineering or surveying from an ABET-accredited curriculum or high school diploma with equivalent related experience is preferred. Experience working on civil engineering and land surveying projects is preferred but will consider training the right applicant. Must pass drug screening and background check. A valid Driver's license and transportation to work is required.

Responsibilities:

- Assist in conducting land surveys using various surveying equipment and techniques.
- Collect and record field data, measurements, and observations.
- Operate and maintain surveying instruments, including GPS, total stations, and levels.
- Use GIS software to process and analyze survey data.
- Assist in the preparation of survey reports, maps, and drawings.
- Perform calculations and computations to support surveying activities.
- Collaborate with team members to ensure accurate and timely completion of projects.

Requirements:

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Previous experience as a survey technician or related field is preferred.
- Proficiency in using hand tools and surveying equipment.
- Strong data analysis skills with the ability to interpret and present findings.
- Knowledge of GIS software and applications.

- Excellent attention to detail and accuracy in measurements and calculations.
